The Minnesota Multistate Contracting Alliance for Pharmacy (MMCAP) is a voluntary group purchasing organization operated and managed by the Materials Management Division of the State of Minnesota's Department of Administration for government healthcare facilities. MMCAP services over 2,000 facilities in 46 states with annual purchases that exceeded \$1.3 billion in 2008. MMCAP's primary function is to provide a full range of pharmaceuticals to its participating facilities, and also to provide contracts for vials and containers, medical supplies, drug testing supplies, returned goods processing, influenza vaccine, and dental supplies.

MMCAP is seeking a Pharmacist to:

- To plan, develop, and implement all clinical and therapeutic phases of MMCAP's volume purchasing plans so that pharmaceutical and related products and services are readily and economically available to MMCAP eligible facilities.;
- Serves as MMCAP liaison to individuals and organizations both within and outside of MMCAP pertaining to clinical and therapeutic matters as they relate to MMCAP's contracts and programs;
- To research and develop new contract specifications and requirements so that pharmaceutical and related products commonly used by MMCAP participating facilities are combined for price advantage and availability, based on sound clinical and therapeutic standards; and
- Advise MMCAP leadership, Materials Management Division management, and Department of Administration management on policies and options related to prescription drug programs and MMCAP's capability to provide services.
