



## **Pharmacy Analyst**

The Minnesota Multistate Contracting Alliance for Pharmacy (MMCAP) is a voluntary group purchasing organization operated and managed by the Materials Management Division of the State of Minnesota's Department of Administration for government healthcare facilities. MMCAP services over 2,000 facilities in 45 states with annual contracting purchases that will exceed \$1.2 billion in 2008. MMCAP's primary function is to provide a full range of pharmaceuticals to its participating facilities, and also for vials and containers, medical supplies, drug testing, returned goods processing, influenza vaccine, and dental supplies.

MMCAP is seeking a Pharmacy Analyst to:

- Ensure MMCAP contract pricing and products are accurately updated for dissemination to MMCAP facility members;
- Review existing contracts and usage data from multiple sources to assist the MMCAP pharmacist in determining best value purchasing for MMCAP facilities considering factors such as facility class of trade, purchasing patterns and the availability of different generic or therapeutically equivalent products;
- Develop and coordinate MMCAP's internal pharmaceutical product and price auditing programs to ensure program accuracy and to meet GPO industry quality assurance expectations; and
- Support clinical pharmacy consulting services and support provided by MMCAP to its member facilities.
